



Young Leaders at Beaver Bonanza 2023

Beaver Bonanza is an activity day for the Beaver Scouts of Derbyshire, held at Drum Hill Scout Camp. To make the event the success which our Beaver colonies have come to expect, we need the volunteer staff members on the day to help run the activities. For any Young Leaders registering as Staff, helping out at Beaver Bonanza will count towards your Young Leader Missions.

Mission 2: Activity

- Helping to **plan** and **organise** an activity (not a game)
- **Deliver** the activity
- Gather **materials** and **equipment** needed

As an activity day, Beaver Bonanza is full of activities that you can help take an active part in the planning, organisation and delivery of.

Planning & Organisation

We will be running some online sessions to go through the planning and organisation part of the various activities, specifically for the Young Leaders who have registered.

Delivery

On the day, deliver the activities that you've helped to plan, and just generally help make sure that the Beaver Scouts have a brilliant day. Of course, that might mean you joining in with a few of the activities during the day as encouragement now and again! You don't need to stay on one activity all day – you can rotate around if you would prefer.

Equipment

Although we will go and actually buy the equipment that is needed, for the activities you have helped to plan, you will need to suggest to us what is needed and where we might be able to find it for the best price.

If you are available to help with setup on the Saturday, and can get to and from the campsite, you're more than welcome to come and help setup the activities you've helped to plan – but be aware that there isn't an option for under 18 staff members to camp over.

Furry Fred's Year in a Day

For those who's never experienced a Beaver Bonanza before, here's a quick run-down of what happens:

Lands

The campsite is split up into 4 "Lands". These are the activity zones. Every beaver spends time in each of the lands, rotating around during the day (2 lands in the morning, 2 in the afternoon).

Participants

We're expecting around 800 Beaver Scouts from across the county to attend the event.

Activities

There will be approximately 20 activities on each land – so lots to do for both the beavers and the staff who are setting up and running things.
